One of the most impactful elements of the International Poverty Forum occurs during the Think Tank poverty roundtable, where a diverse group of thought leaders from around the world in the private, public, and non-profit sectors meet to help turn ideas into action. The event is notable for its engaging discussions, wide participation, and action-oriented approach to addressing the multifaceted challenges of poverty.

Impacting Change

Based on these conversations, Caring For Others has addressed pressing challenges that vulnerable communities face in four key regions – Grenada, Antigua, Guyana, and South Africa. Each country has benefited from targeted initiatives tailored to meet local needs, such as No Bare Soles, disaster relief, food security, youth education, and elderly support programs.

Economic Empowerment

Micro Economic Loans

While meeting immediate needs such as food and clothing, Caring For Others efforts also focus on long-term solutions, including education, entrepreneurship, and community resilience through its Micro Economic Community Empowerment (MECE) Program.

By providing life skills, education, and job training for employment opportunities indigenous to the region, Caring For Others ensures that the individuals it serves have the means to transform their lives and become self-reliant.

Examples of support include providing fishing equipment, sewing machines, agriculture equipment and construction materials among many others.

International hubs have been developed in the Caribbean, South America, West Africa, Belize, Santo Domingo and the Philippines.

Grants

- Provides a clear and specific vision of what it wishes to do and how it aims to achieve its goals
- Identifies the benefits/differences that will be derived from the project for its target group
- Delivers a strong management committee that is dedicated, reputable, and efficiently run
- Shares statements that prove finances are regulated and in order
- Initiatives tailored to meet local needs, such as No Bare Soles, disaster relief, food security, youth education, and elderly support programs.
